Founded in 2009, the National HART (Heart Attack Rescue Training) Foundation is built on a highly successful program previously operated by the Los Angeles Fire Department. During a 5-year period, thousands of LA high school students received training by Fire Department staff, paramedics and Explorer Scouts who were specially trained to teach CPR and AED skills. Believing in the importance of the HART program, the National HART Foundation received permission from the LAFD to re-launch the program with the goal of growing it into a national organization.
